City of Kyle Parks and Recreation staff is ready to help Kyle residents dispose of their Christmas Trees. Natural Christmas Trees make excellent mulch that can be used in City Parks and Landscape projects to make our facilities more enjoyable year round. Simply bring your tree - real ones only please, no artificial trees will be accepted - to one of three Kyle City Parks. These parks include Gregg-Clark, Steeplechase and Waterleaf Parks. Be sure to remove all decorations and stands.

Fireworks Illegal in Kyle

Please keep your New Year's celebrations fun, safe and legal. Fireworks can provide a brilliant light show and lots of excitement. They can also disturb neighbors, scare pets, and cause damage to property and injury to people if not used properly.

It is illegal to sell, own, discharge, transport, or otherwise possess fireworks in Kyle.

Persons found with fireworks in Kyle are subject to a fine between \$500 and \$2000. To report illegal fireworks, call the Kyle Police Department at 512-268-3232 or 911.

City staff has been experimenting with various options for making the meetings more accessible for the public since council members requested it in October. The free hosting service is provided by UStream.tv which uses limited advertising to provide the service.

Kyle Mayor Lucy Johnson, and Mrs. Kate Johnson, donated the camera to be used in the broadcasts. Kyle staff will evaluate how many people are viewing the meetings online and will make a recommendation to council later in the year about upgrading to more sophisticated hosting option.
