## Kyle City Council Approves New Library

The Kyle city council unanimously approved moving forward with the construction of a new library during its regularly scheduled meeting on May 18<sup>th</sup>.

The approved budget of \$3.657 million was over the \$3.2 million target set by the council last year, but council members agreed that project was long overdue and that the final result would be worth the extra expenditures.

The new Kyle Library, located in the western part of Kyle's historic downtown, will be 20,000 square feet and will feature community rooms to accommodate meetings and gatherings as well as special areas for teens and young children. Expanded computer areas and an outdoor plaza and amphitheater feature will also be included. The exterior of the building will feature limestone and brick and will mirror Kyle's architectural brand established with the construction of its new City Hall four years ago.

Kyle's current 5,000 square foot library is located in the heart of downtown Kyle and has served the community since 1962. Since then, Kyle has grown from a small ranching community to a full service city of approximately 30,000. Much of Kyle's growth has occurred over the past 10 years when the city was the fifth fastest growing city in Texas.

Construction of the new library is expected to start as early October of this year with completion expected by the end of 2011. The architect is BLGY, Inc and the contractor is Raymond Construction, Inc.
