The City of Kyle to Remove Water Restrictions, Moves Continuing Water Use Management

Thanks to recent rains, the City's water sources are slowly raising, allowing for the removal of water restrictions beginning January 1st. Please continue to review current restrictions and do your part to conserve water. Restrictions may need to be reinstated if drought conditions return.

Follow these rules to help conserve Kyle's water and reduce your monthly water bill:

- Regularly check for leaks, including broken sprinkler heads, leaking valves, leaking or broken pipes, or leaking faucets.

Do not operate a irrigation system with

- a broken head
- a head that is out of adjustment where the arc of the spray head is over a street or parking lot
- a head that is misting due to high water pressure
- Don't allow water to run off property such that there is a trail of water running in the street for a distance of 50 feet or greater
- Don't allow water to pond in the street or parking lot to a depth greater than 1/4 inch.

Check the City of Kyle Web site at www.cityofkyle.com for the most current water management status.

The City of Kyle Parks & Recreation Department sets up "drop-off" areas at the City's Parks to drop off your natural Christmas Trees.

All decorations and lights, including tinsel, must be removed. No artificial trees. No nails or screws. No tree bases.

The current drop-off points are:
Gregg-Clarke Park, Steeplechase Park & Waterleaf Park
