Monday, May 25 – 10am – Ceremonies & reading of veteran names at the Kyle Cemetery.

The public is invited to both these events. The Kyle/Buda VFW and Cub and Boy Scout Troops will be placing flags on the graves of veterans. On Saturday, Boy Scout Troop 112 will be serving Hot Dogs at the American Legion Hall from 11:30am-12:30pm.

Thunderhill Raceway honors Military

Thunderhill Raceway (THR) will be presenting Operation Interdependence® Night at the Races this Saturday, May 23, starting at 6:00 p.m.

Thunderhill Raceway will honor the military at this event, so plan to spend part of your Memorial Day weekend at the races. Lots of racing action is on the agenda, including the TSRS (Texas Super Racing Series) Late Models and Allison Legacys, SportMods and Dwarf Car Racing Series of Texas - along with the THR ASA A-Line Super Stocks, Thunder Stocks, Grand Stocks, Mini Stocks and NasKarts.

The grandstand gates will open at 5:00 p.m. Qualifying will take place at 5:30 p.m., followed by heat races at 6:00 p.m. Opening ceremonies are scheduled for 7:00 p.m., followed by the feature races. THR is also honored that some of the Wounded Warriors from Fort Sam Houston will also be attending the races on Saturday.
