Interested applicants are asked to send a letter of intent plus a statement of residency to Hays CISD Elections Administrator, 21003 Interstate 35, Kyle, 78640. Deadline to apply is 4 p.m., Friday, Nov. 20. Letters of intent should include the applicant's phone number and/or email address.
